The Department of Residence Life at the State University of New York at Geneseo is seeking a pool of candidates for the position of Residence Hall Director for the 2010-11 academic year. We seek entry-level professionals whose academic interests and experiences include residential education, leadership development, a commitment to diversity, and an understanding of the needs of students transitioning to college. We value colleagues who demonstrate intellectual curiosity and evidence of a commitment to academic excellence. Qualified applicants will have strong written and oral communication skills.

The RD appointment is a full-time, live-in, 10-month position during the academic year. Responsibilities run from August 1, 2010 through May 31, 2011.

Residence Hall Directors at SUNY Geneseo are educators outside the classroom. We seek a professional staff committed to co-curricular education as a complement to Geneseo students' rich curricular experiences.

Job Summary and Application Process

RDs at Geneseo live in apartments in their residence halls, supervise and train a paraprofessional staff of RAs, serve in the campus Conduct system, participate in committees across campus, and oversee the residential education of approximately 200 students. The Department of Residence Life currently includes several residential college houses (Dante House, Writers House, Eco House), and seeks to develop Geneseo's residential college system.

Residential students at Geneseo are active in national and regional residence hall organizations; both NEACURH and NACURH have recognized our students' commitment to residence life with awards for campus programs and individual student leaders, including national honors for Geneseo's NRHH chapter. RDs regularly present papers and programs at regional and national Student Life conferences and run leadership workshops on campus. Many RDs also take advantage of opportunities to work collaboratively with other offices of the Division of Student and Campus Life, such as Orientation, First Year Seminars, the College Union & Activities, Greek Affairs, Health and Counseling, and Career Services.

SUNY Geneseo will be screening applicants in on-campus interviews as well as at the Western New York Placement Exchange in March. Applicants should indicate their communication strengths through the written materials they submit. All campus interviews will include a prompted presentation on a current issue in student life.

Minimum qualifications include a Bachelor's degree and professional or paraprofessional experience in residence life or commensurate experience in student life. Geneseo's strong residential education program requires RDs who think of themselves as educators. Preference will be given to candidates with Master's degrees, or those expecting the completion of the Master's degree in 2010-11.

This position requires flexibility of work hours, including some work performed on weekends and evenings. Each RD participates in "on-call" duty, requiring periodic overnight monitoring of a duty phone and the ability to respond to emergency situations.
